Newsletters are a great way to communicate with the families of children in your program and other stakeholders, and are a perfect place to share your Maryland EXCELS quality rating. You also may contact local organizations that have newsletters, such as a local elementary school or a nearby recreation center, to ask if they would include information about your program and your Maryland EXCELS quality rating.

The newsletter content template below has blue bracketed areas to fill in with your information.

Pro Tips:

- Create a regular schedule for your newsletter so that families can expect it at a certain time of the week, month, or year.
- Keep it short and sweet. Make sure to cover items that are relevant to the families in your program.
- Use images, graphics, and bullet points to break up large blocks of text and highlight the most important information.
- Share information about what makes your program unique. Highlight opportunities for families to engage in the program or extend learning experiences at home.

Programs with a quality rating of 5 meet the highest standards in Maryland EXCELS and are state or nationally accredited.
