The Accredited Programs badge.

Narrator: Accredited Programs. This achievement recognizes programs that have obtained accreditation from an agency recognized by the Maryland State Department of Education, demonstrating their commitment to meeting rigorous quality standards in early childhood education.

The Asthma and Allergy Friendly badge.

Narrator: Asthma and Allergy Friendly. Programs that earn this achievement have implemented policies and practices to create safe and supportive environments for children with asthma and allergies, ensuring their health and well-being while in your care.

The Cultural and Linguistic Competency badge.

Narrator: Cultural and Linguistic Competency. This achievement focuses on promoting cultural diversity and inclusivity within programs, including practices that support the cultural and linguistic needs of children and families from diverse backgrounds.

The Eco-Friendly Program badge.
